CALL FOR PAPERS: Interlinkages between social justice and sustainable development in Jordan

With the Eastern Mediterranean warming at a faster pace than the rest of the world, climate-related conditions severely strain **Jordan's water supplies** and therefore put the agricultural sector and industry under significant stress while, at the same time, putting **people's livelihoods** at risk through low access to water for drinking and sanitation. In addition, the high number of refugees hosted in Jordan further increases this water-related strain and the **pressure on the social system and local communities**. In the current context, the war in Ukraine is also raising a lot of questions about the potential threat for food security in Mediterranean countries.

Therefore, EuroMeSCo invites think tankers and researchers to reflect on the relevant interlinkages between social justice and sustainable development in times of significant climate-induced risks, with particular attention paid to vulnerable groups, including women and youths. Furthermore, it encourages to explore the role of local communities and social dialogue in this broad framework, presently and in the future.

The selection process will be completed by 29 April 2022. All applicants will be notified by e-mail of the results of their application.

Selected authors will be asked to elaborate on the proposal.
